In addition to his role at the Ministry of Investment he is a member of several Government senior committees, advising on investment, on international trade, and on business policy.

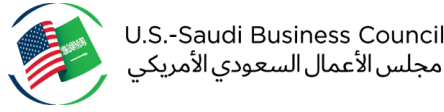
